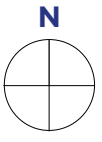







Welcome to the Yeovil College public consultation event

This project forms part of the wider Further Education Capital Transformation (FECT) programme funded by the DfE to improve the condition of the existing college estate across the UK. Yeovil College is one of sixteen Colleges that have been targeted within Phase 2 of the FECT programme where the condition of buildings is most critical

This is a condition led programme to improve the quality and performance of learning spaces.

A detailed assessment of the condition of the Colleges buildings concluded that three buildings are at the end of their useful life, the Kingston building, Bridge building and the College's Sports hall. The proposal will demolish and replace these facilities.
